Math: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Secondary 1, 2, and 3. Secondary 3 can be replaced by an Applied Course with written parent request 	3.0
Science: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A total of two Foundational Courses plus one credit from any of the five areas 	3.0
Social Studies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2.5 credits from the Foundational Courses plus .5 elective from any area 	3.0
Fine Arts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Credits may be earned in visual arts, music, dance, theater and/or media arts 	1.5
PE and Health Education <ul style="list-style-type: none"> PE Skills, Fitness, Lifetime Activities, and Health 	2.0
Career Technology Education (CTE) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Credits may be earned in a variety of CTE Pathway areas (Ex: Architecture and Construction; Arts, Audio/Visual Technology and Communications; Business, Finance and Marketing; etc.) 	1.0
